11	<u>A sample answer:</u> Any three of the followings: 1. Business understanding: There are three main elements to the business understanding stage: setting the objectives, developing the project plan and establishing the criteria for success. 2. Data Understanding: The data understanding stage involves an initial collection of data. This is normally collected from various sources that are available. Once the data is collected, the integrity, accuracy and the properties of the data are considered, to make sure that it is viable. 3. Data preparation: This is the largest stage in the project and the most time consuming. During this stage the data is taken through a whole process of selection, cleansing, construction and formatting, to make sure that it is in the form required for the business. This can then allow for patterns and trends to be established in the data, relating to the business needs. 4. Data modelling: During this stage, various test scenarios are generated to model the data. This will allow the business to understand whether the models are suitable for the business needs, and that the models fall in line with the business initiatives. 5. Evaluation: In the evaluation stage, the results generated by the models are evaluated. The outcome of this evaluation may produce new business needs, depending on the patterns and trends that have been identified in the process. 6. Deployment: The deployment stage normally involves creating a report and other visual material to present the findings of the data mining process to the stakeholders of a business. 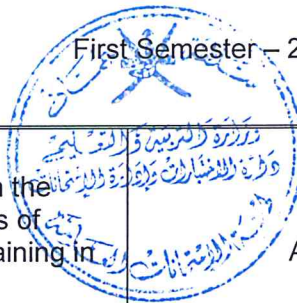

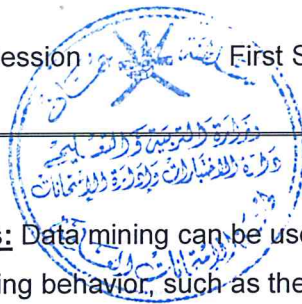

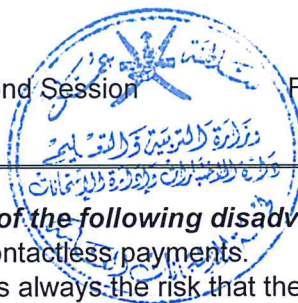
